Coach Angel Leka

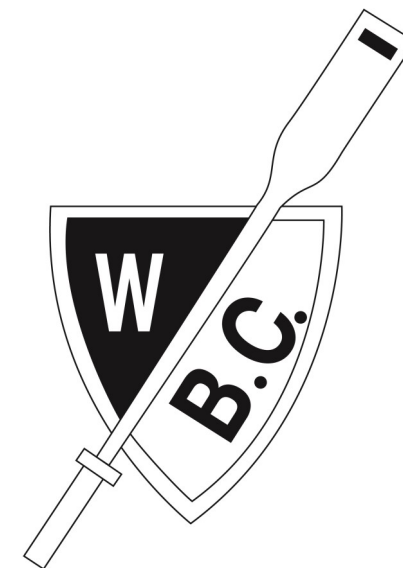
Coach Angel rowed for Southgate High School and the WBC. He currently coaches for Crestwood High School and the WBC masters.
