The Wyandotte Boat Club Rowing Camps provide an opportunity to learn the basics of rowing in a fun environment. Register today - both camps will be limited to 30 rowers.

Youth Rowing Camps: For students entering 7th- 9th grades.

High School Camps: For students entering 10th – 12th grades.

- No experience needed, camps will teach the fundamentals of rowing
- Camps will run Monday-Friday for two weeks for a total of 20 instruction hours
- Camp fee of \$130 includes: introduction into the sport of rowing; proper protocol in the Boathouse; technical instruction on rowing machines and water; a camp t-shirt; Regatta and a picnic on the last day.
- All rowers must complete a basic swim test that will be held on Day 2 of each session (location TBA)
- All rowing boats will be accompanied by a motor launch with WBC-approved coaches, and experienced rowers will join the campers in each boat.

- Note: Pre-registration is not required but encouraged as both camps will be limited to 30 rowers. Registration forms with payment can be either mailed to WBC or dropped off in the Lounge.
